Smoking Policy

It is the policy of Huntly Football Club to prohibit smoking in all club premises

This policy has been implemented to protect all employees, volunteers, supporters and visitors from exposure to second hand smoke.

Smoking is not permitted within our buildings, the main stand or any internal spaces as prescribed in legislation.

Signs are displayed at entrances and in vehicles in accordance with statutory requirements.

Smoking is also not permitted in any private vehicle when used on company business if it is being used to carry passengers.

The Club Health and Safety Officer is the designated person to whom breaches of this policy should be reported but any member of Club staff or authorised volunteer will assist where issues are identified.
